All Worlds Bid teams will be judged by the SAME 1 Panel of Judges.

**PAID BIDS**

All teams in the following divisions will be given the opportunity to compete for a PAID Bid to the Cheerleading Worlds.

- ▶ All Senior Level 6 All-Girl & Coed Divisions
- ▶ All Senior Open Level 6 All-Girl & Coed Divisions
- ▶ All International Open Level 6 & 7 Divisions
- ▶ All International Level 6 NT and Globals Divisions

**THE PAID BID (\$25,000 MAX) WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:**

- **1<sup>st</sup> PAID BID** - Highest Combined Score of all Senior/ Senior Open Teams. This bid must be awarded to the highest scoring team among All Senior/Senior Open Worlds eligible divisions.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> PAID BID** - Highest Combined Score of all Worlds eligible divisions determined among Highest scoring teams among different scoresheets. The Panel of Worlds Judges will review the routines of the highest-scoring team adjudicated under the United Scoring System, IASF Scoring System and NT/Globals teams. The Panel of Worlds Judges will determine which team has the best chance to advance at the Cheerleading Worlds regardless of which team's score is technically higher.
- **3<sup>rd</sup> PAID BID** - Will go to 1 of the next 3 Highest Scores of all Worlds eligible divisions (United Scoring and IASF Scoring System or the highest scoring NT/Globals Division Team. This 3rd and final bid will be awarded among these eligible teams as listed above. The Worlds Panel will decide between these teams regardless of score. The Worlds Panel Judges will review both Days performances of these 4 teams and decide based on the performances which team has the best chance to advance at the Cheerleading Worlds regardless of which team's score is technically higher.

**AT-LARGE BIDS**

All teams in the following divisions will be given the opportunity to compete for 9 AT-LARGE Bids to the Cheerleading Worlds.

- All Senior/Senior Open Level 6 All-Girl Divisions
- All Senior/Senior Open Level 6 Co-ed Divisions
- All International Open Level 6 & 7 All-Girl & Co-ed Divisions
- All International NT & Globals Divisions

**THE AT-LARGE BIDS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:** At-Large Bids for All Teams will be based on a combination of scores and the Worlds Panel of Judge's evaluation of a team's likelihood of success at the USASF Cheerleading Worlds.

- The Senior Level 6 and Senior Open Level 6 Divisions are guaranteed at least 2 bids (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The International Open Level 6 & 7 divisions are guaranteed at least 2 Bids (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The NT/Globals Division are guaranteed at least 1 Bid (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The Next At-large Bids (Between 1 and 9 Bids - depending on how many Senior 6/International 6/7, NT/Globals bid eligible teams received At- Large or Paid Bids will be determined by the Worlds Judging Panel and will be made on a team's overall score and likelihood of success at the Cheerleading Worlds, regardless of which team's score is technically higher.

**TEAM BID LIMITATIONS:** A team may receive no more than one bid to The Cheerleading Worlds for any





**THE AT-LARGE BIDS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:** At-Large Bids for All Teams will be based on a combination of scores and the Worlds Panel of Judge’s evaluation of a team’s likelihood of success at the USASF Cheerleading Worlds.

- The Senior Level 6 and Senior Open Level 6 Divisions are guaranteed at least 2 bids (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The International Open Level 6 & 7 divisions are guaranteed at least 2 Bids (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The NT/Globals Division are guaranteed at least 1 Bid (between Paid and At-Large) to the Cheerleading Worlds.
- The Next At-large Bids (Between 1 and 9 Bids - depending on how many Senior 6/International 6/7, NT/Globals bid eligible teams received At- Large or Paid Bids will be determined by the Worlds Judging Panel and will be made on a team’s overall score and likelihood of success at the Cheerleading Worlds, regardless of which team’s score is technically higher.

**TEAM BID LIMITATIONS:** A team may receive no more than one bid to The Cheerleading Worlds for any given division. A team that has accepted an at-large bid is eligible to compete for a Paid Bid. If a team chooses to compete for a new at-large bid, they must **DECLINE** the original at-large bid **BEFORE** competing on Day 1 for the new at-large bid. The process to **DECLINE** a bid includes: 1. writing to the sponsoring event producer; 2. writing to the USASF regional director and Steve Peterson, [speterson@usasf.net](mailto:speterson@usasf.net); and 3. following confirmation of the declined bid, updating the Worlds Bid section on the dashboard of your USASF program membership profile. **BID ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible for a paid AND/OR at-large bid from JAMZ, at least 80% of your program must attend a JAMZ regional and/or the JAMZ All Star National Championship (or a combination of the above). If your program’s location is NOT within a 100-mile radius of a JAMZ event during the 2022-2023 season, **THREE** teams must register AND perform at the 2023 JAMZ All Star National Championship to be eligible. This rule is necessary to prevent/avoid the spoilage of Paid and/or At-Large Bids and to allow teams the necessary substitutions for Worlds. Exceptions to this policy can be made based on program size and program participation at current and future JAMZ events. Exceptions will be made at the discretion of the JAMZ VP David Sims.
